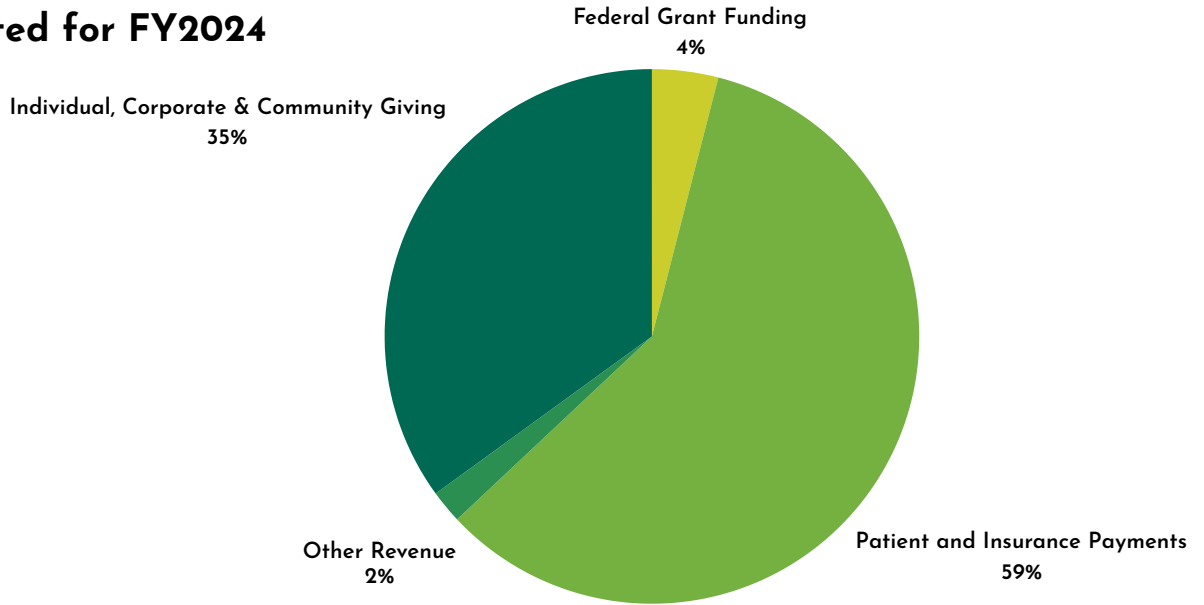

99% of our patients are living at/below 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines

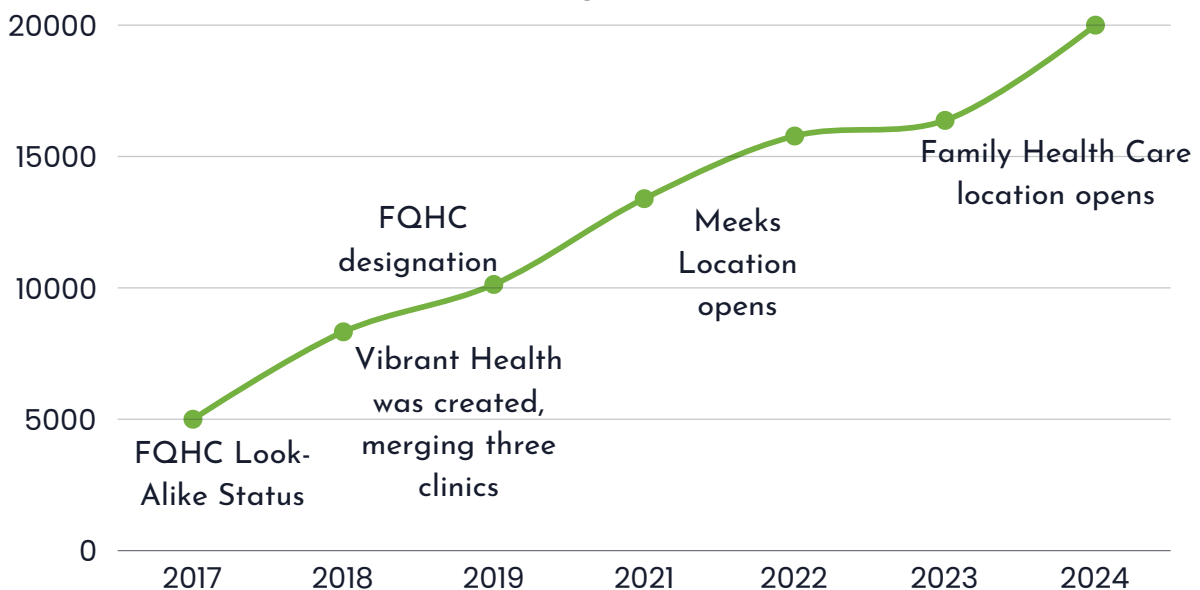
3 out of 5

FAQs

Doesn't your funding come from the government?

Federal reimbursement amounts to about 4% of our operating budget. This is unique to Vibrant compared to other local community health centers because the federal grants to build baseline funding have been frozen since the COVID-19 pandemic. We anticipate this will open up in 2025 and until that time, philanthropy and other revenue streams must fill this gap. That leaves most of our budget (and about 9 million in charity care we give away) to be brought in through patient revenue, insurance, and individual giving like you.

Does my donation really make an impact?

Yes. Individual donations not only help us offset operating costs, they help us build additional programs such as our community health workers who provide mobile care throughout the community. It also allows us to make up some of the \$9 million we annually give away in charity care.
